IGBC has launched student's chapter in G H Patel College of Engineering on 15th of October, 2015. Since then, every year in the month of September IGBC Week is celebrated with various themes and activities under this student chapter.

This year the theme of the Week celebration was "#ActOnClimate". Under the theme, we came with an idea of celebrating different activities like Expert talks, Photography contest, Quiz competition, Elocution competition etc. on virtual platform through Microsoft Teams.

IGBC Week Celebration was inaugurated by Mr. Bavesh Shah, Chairman of IGBC Vadodara chapter, Mr. Himanshu Shah - Executive Officer of IGBC, Dr. Shivraj Dhaka - Counsellor, CII – IGBC, Dr. Himanshu Soni - Principal GCET, Dr. Khadeeja Priyan -Professor and Head, Civil Engineering Department, GCET on 23rd September, 2020. The Chief Guest of the inaugural programme was Mr. Bavesh Shah, Chairman of IGBC Vadodara chapter. As many as 150 students & faculty members participated in this Celebration.

Dr. Himanshu Soni, Principal, GCET delivered the welcome address and addressed the audience about the need to act on climate and appreciating the department for organising such events during this pandemic for the welfare of students as well as for the society. All the invitees were introduced to the audience by Dr. Khadeeja Priyan, Professor and Head, Civil Engineering Department, GCET. Then Mr. Bhavesh Shah, Chairman of IGBC Vadodara chapter addressed the gathering and Mr. Himanshu Shah, Executive Officer of IGBC, introduced the audience about IGBC. The inaugural function ended with the Vote of Thanks by Prof. Krunali Patel (Faculty Coordinator).

Under this IGBC week Celebration, two expert talks were organized on this theme on $23^{\rm rd}$ September, 2020. The first speaker of the day Dr. Shivraj Dhaka, Counsellor, CII – IGBC introduced the audience to the concept of net zero energy building and the approaches to achieve net zero energy buildings. He explained about CFM based, bi-facial solar PV systems through which a net zero energy building can be constructed. He also shared some case studies to the audience.

Another speaker of the day, Dr. Yashkumar Shukla, Technical Director (Energy System), CARBSE, CEPT University, Ahmedabad introduced audience to some of the analysis techniques of net zero energy buildings. He also shared a survey which he did on a net zero energy building. Also, he mentioned techniques on which one can save energy in our buildings.

Under this celebration various activities like quiz competition, elocution competition and photography competition was organized on 25th September 2020. The event was managed by student coordinators Aditya Dalwadi & Sachi Shah from 3rd year Civil Engineering. The elocution competition was on current topic "Impact of covid-19 on society" and the students shared their views on this new-normal. This college was affiliated to Sardar Patel University from the year 1996 to 2008. later on from the year 2008, Institute is affiliated to Gujarat Technological University. New admission from year 2020 will be done under the Charutar Vidyamandal University (CVM University).

Civil Engineering is the youngest department in the college established in the academic year of 2014 - 15 with an intake of 60, affiliated to GTU, Ahmedabad The department has 10 qualified faculty members and has developed all the necessary laboratories and infrastructure facilities. Civil Engineering department has organized various technical events like Expert Talks, Seminars, Industrial Visits, Technical Quiz competition, Group Discussion and Workshops for the students.
