"Water Conservation Awareness Program" (As a part of World Water Day – 2021)

Department of Civil Engineering, GCET had organized "Water Conservation Awareness Program" (As a part of World Water Day – 2021) on Saturday, 13^{th} March 2021. Two expert talks and quiz and group discussion activities were organized during the program. The program was organized for 1^{st} year students of all branches and 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} & 4^{th} year civil engineering students. Total of 60 students took active participation in the program.

AIM:

The main objective of the program was to spread the awareness and importance of water in our lives and water conservation practices.

About the experts:

- Dr. Eldho T. I. is a professor and working as a head of the civil engineering department at IIT Bombay, Mumbai. He is having 25+ years of teaching and research experience. His research area includes Groundwater flow and Pollution investigations, Computational Fluid Dynamics, Coastal Hydrodynamics, Watershed management, Climate change impact assessment on water resources and coastal region etc. He is having numerous publications in various reputed well known national and international journals, Conferences, Book chapters etc.
- 2) Dr. S. D. Dhiman is a professor in civil engineering department at BVM Engineering College at Vallabh Vidyanagar, Anand. He is having 34+ years of teaching experience. His research aera includes Groundwater hydrology, Water resources engineering, Hydroinformatics etc. He is having various publications in national and international journals, conferences etc.

About the Program:

The program commenced with delightful prayer followed by greetings and introduction of the program to everyone at 10 am in GCET Auditorium. Participants were gathered in Autditorium while experts joined online from their respective places. Next Dr. Khadeeja Priyan, Professor & Head of Civil Engineering Department has introduced and welcomed the invited experts for the program Dr. Eldho T. I. and Dr. S. D. Dhiman. Next Dr. Himanshu Soni, Prinicpal, GCET has addressed the gathering and highlighted the importance of such program to all the participants. After the inauguration program the first session started by Dr. Eldho T. I. at 10:30 am.







Dr. Eldho T. I. delivered a talk on *Water Conservation for Sustainable Water Resources Management & Impacts of Climate Change* in context of World Water Day theme Valuing Water. He began his talk with the introduction of world water day and his history and also the theme of the year 'Valuing Water'. Then he started explaining about water resources supply. Also, he shared about consumption of water and highlighted mainly about water scarcity. After this introductory part he discussed about Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) put forward by United Nations. He mainly highlighted about goal number 6 out of 17 goals which is related to water. He also shared his knowledge regarding necessity of sustainable water resources management through IWRM (Integrated Water Resources Management). He interestingly discussed about how to build a National Water Security System and Water Safety Plans (WHO) to all the participants. He has also highlighted about India's water resources mainly. He also emphasized about various measures one can adapt to tackle theses impacts. The session was very much interesting and brainstorming for all the participants.

After the first talk by Eldho sir, the next talk was carried out at 11:30 am by another expert of the program Dr. S. D. Dhiman. Dr. S. D. Dhiman delivered a talk on *Groundwater Protection in Coastal Areas*. He commenced his talk with the discussion about Water Crisis in India and global scenario. He then discussed about global water demand in various sector and out of which he made understand the participants about water scarcity. He shared his knowledge about various causes of water scarcity and about water management issues everyone is facing. Afterwards he discussed about ground water sources. He mainly discussed about various reasons by which the groundwater is getting contaminated and why it is important to protect it. He especially discussed about groundwater protection in coastal areas mainly from salinity. The lecture was very good.

The knowledge and awareness spread by experts were highly appreciated by all the participants of the program and the learnt so much.




