Patel College of Engineering & Technology in collaboration with the GCET CodeChef Chapter celebrated CSI DAY 2022 by organizing a full-day event, named, CODE YUDDHA 2.0.

There were several logical and analytical problem statements. It assessed the participants' coding and time management abilities. Data Structures and Algorithms, one of the most crucial areas for aspiring programmers, were the focus of the problems. The competition was open to students in their first, second, third, and fourth years of study in all areas of engineering.

The Event flow was:

- 9:30 AM to 10:15 AM Introductory Session
- 10:30 AM to 12:00 AM Round 1
- 1:30 PM Onwards Auction Round
- 3:30 PM Onwards Round 2

Round Details:

The coding problems varied from basic to medium implementation, which made students apply different approaches to a single problem and develop their reasoning and logical skills.

- First Round had 4 questions on basic coding and simple data structures. Top 48 participants were selected for the next round.
- The top 8 Participants were selected as captains and they go through the auction round for the team selection for Round 2 and selected their team members.
- Round 2 had 6 different questions on different Data Structures. Each Team Member solved any one of them individually as per their skills.
