A PLATFORM SHOWCASING UNIQUE IDEAS, INNOVATIVE WORK, AND DISTINCT INDUSTRIAL EXPERIENCES OF STUDENTS

1. Objective:

The poster presentation at **Avinya 2026** aims to provide a platform for final-year students to showcase their industrial internship work in a clear and visually engaging manner. It enables students to demonstrate their technical understanding and practical exposure gained during the internship, while promoting effective communication with faculty and industry experts.

2. Content & Design Guidelines:

- Prefer images, diagrams, charts, and visuals over long text.
- Keep text concise and to the point.
- Use bullet points instead of paragraphs.
- Maintain proper alignment and spacing.
- Ensure logical flow and readability.

3. Display Facilities:

- One display panel will be provided per poster. To fit properly, posters must be of size **30 inches (width) × 40 inches (height)** with **0.5-inch margin** on all sides.
- The display area will be adequately lit with a **light-colored background**.
- Posters must be **flex printed**.
- Content should be **readable from a distance of 6 feet (2 meters)**.
- The poster should be **self-explanatory**, enabling viewers to understand the work without detailed verbal explanation.
- **Top Section (Center Aligned)** must include (**See the header of this file + Title of the Project**):
 - G H Patel College of Engineering & Technology
 - The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) University
 - Department of Computer Engineering
 - GCET Logo (Left side) & CVMU Logo (Right side)
 - **Title of the Project**
- **Bottom Section** must include:
 - Student Name, Branch and Enrollment Number
 - Industry Mentor's Details (Name, Designation, Company Name, City)
 - Internal Guide Details (Name, Designation, CP Department, GCET)

4. Suggested Fonts and Sizes:

- Use **clean, readable sans-serif fonts** such as Arial, Helvetica, Lato, Open Sans, or Verdana etc.
- Avoid serif fonts (harder to read from distance)
- **Recommended sizes:**
 - Title:** 86 pt
 - Names / Guide / Contributors:** 48 pt
 - Headings:** 36 pt
 - Body Text:** 30 pt
 - Figure Captions:** 25 pt

5. Suggested Sections of the Poster:

Students are advised to organize their poster with the following sections. However, the exact content and emphasis may be tailored based on the nature of the work, in consultation with your Internal Guide.

- Introduction / Background
- Problem Statement / Objective
- Methodology / Approach
- Tools & Technologies Used
- Work Done / Implementation
- Results / Outcomes
- Challenges Faced (if any)
- Conclusion
- Future Scope
- Any other relevant details

6. Evaluation Parameters (Total - 50 Marks):

I. Technical Content & Understanding (20 Marks)

- Clarity of problem statement, objectives, and methodology
- Depth of technical knowledge and correctness of work
- Quality of results and ability to answer questions

II. Poster Design & Visual Presentation (15 Marks)

- Layout, organization, and Adherence to prescribed guidelines (size, format, sections)
- Readability and clarity of content (fonts, spacing, structure)
- Effective use of visuals and concise presentation

III. Communication & Presentation Skills (15 Marks)

- Clarity and confidence in explanation
- Logical flow and highlighting key contributions
- Interaction with evaluators and professionalism
